Township Manager's Report

Cary Vargo summarized his monthly report: the Park Road pedestrian bridge has been delivered, is being "stored" at Hickory Park and weather permitting, will be installed after the Holidays; Garrett Sullivan's Eagle Scout project was the installation of a flagpole at Fellowship Fields, with the help of the Operating Engineers (crane) and Al Gaspari; the Act 209 Committee met to re-prioritize the capital improvement projects, and the Board will be requested to adopt the project schedule via Resolution; Cary has been conducting safety inspections at all wastewater treatment facilities as part of the Township's Safety Program; the Marsh Creek Eagles 105 lb. Team played in the Pop Warner Super Bowl this week, held in Florida.

Guy Donatelli commented that Mike Holmes' term as Lionville Fire Company Chief has expired and Mike Chatham will be the new Fire Chief.

Kevin Kerr commented that Hankin has approached the Township regarding LED billboards and he is not in favor.

Paul Ricken, on behalf of all GEYA Teams, thanked the Township for use of the first-class athletic fields and looks forward to another successful season in 2012.
