Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. Will my property receive public sewer access?

There is no planned change to how your system works. Currently, your facility has public sewer, and after the modifications, your facility will continue to have service.

2. What is the cost for public sewer access?

No costs to the businesses.

3. Will all businesses be required to connect?

Yes.

4. Where will the sanitary sewers and pump station be located?

Please refer to the [Projects](#) page Eaglepointe WWTP map delineating the anticipated work. Currently, low-pressure pumping stations convey the sewage flow from most of the serviced businesses, and gravity sewer for the businesses adjacent to the supermarket. For the most part, all sewer service lines from each building will remain the same.

5. Who is paying for the sewer system expansion?

The Township through a municipal bond will be funding the construction of the sewer system. The bond will be funded through the user fees charged by the Municipal Authority.

6. Will someone be available to answer questions for me as the project progresses?
