NEW SOLID WASTE CONTRACT TO TAKE EFFECT IN AUGUST 2024

CHESTER SPRINGS, PA – At their meeting on March 18, 2024, and after undertaking the required competitive bidding process, the Board of Supervisors awarded the new trash and recycling contract to one hauler, AJ Blosenski. AJ Blosenski will be collecting trash, recycling and yard waste.

The new contracts will take effect on August 5th and 6th, 2024.

Will the pickup schedule change? No, neither the pickup zones nor the collection days will change. Zone 1 pickup will continue to be Monday. Zone 2 pickup will continue to be Tuesday.

Bulk waste will be collected on the third pickup of the month. Yard waste will be collected **twice** a month on Wednesdays throughout the year. To schedule pickup of freon items, please call Upper Uwchlan Public Works at 610-458-2318.

The 24 yard waste collections calendar can be found on the Upper Uwchlan Township website. **Dates are subject to change. Please refer to the Township website and sign up for calendar notifications at upperuwchlan-pa.gov/NotifyMe.**

Don't overload your yard waste bags. Yard waste must be placed in biodegradable paper bags or open containers. Do not use your UUT Toters for yard waste, and don't overload bags or bins. Do not fill bins or bags with wet material or dirt. **Bins or bags containing non-approved waste will not be collected and will be marked with an orange non-collection sticker.** Residents are reminded that there are 2 roll off containers for yard waste materials (only) located at the Upper Uwchlan Public Works Facility, 132 Oscar Way, Chester Springs, PA 19425. These roll off containers are accessible 24/7.

Recycle Right! Many paper, plastic, and metal materials are recyclable – but some aren't! Review the Township's Recycle Right flyer for details about which items are acceptable. **Plastic bags are NOT accepted; Place materials directly in the bin. If your recyclables are contaminated with trash, the hauler will not collect them, and will mark the items or bins with an orange non-collection sticker. THANK YOU!**
